The seminar will review methodologies and research frameworks used for this kind of tools.

The organizers of the Research Seminar invite papers and posters relevant to the theme of the seminar for presentations and discussion on data from different countries, paradigms and theoretical frameworks used for studying eating habits, methodologies for data collection and data processing used in different countries. Presentation on qualitative methodologies used before (for construct the questionnaire), in parallel or after the quantitative survey are also welcome.

- A review committee will conduct a refereed screening of abstracts.
- Authors of accepted abstracts will be asked to submit full papers or posters.

- Once the paper or poster is accepted, at least one of the authors must register to present the paper at the seminar or support the poster at poster session.
- Best paper and poster designated as the most outstanding in each category shall receive an award.
